## 1 Thessalonians Chapter 1

- I. INCLUSION (v. 1)
  - Paul, Silas, and Timothy; all 3 together
  - Unity and inclusion
  - Church "in" God & Jesus, the idea of resting
  - GRACE & PEACE
    - o Grace always comes first, Gr. Charis (charity)
    - o Peace is the result of the grace
- II. INTERCESSION (v. 2-10)
  - 1. ELECTION by God (v. 2-5)
    - A. ACCEPTANCE
      - "Give thanks", continual action
      - Makes mention always due to remembrance of the church
      - "Remembering without ceasing"
        - Paul in constant state of awareness
        - o Perpetual reliance on God
      - What does Paul remember?
        - o THE work of THE faith
          - The effort toward persuasion in truth
        - THE labor of THE love
          - The work that leads to weariness, exhaustion for love
          - Gr. agape (unconditional)
        - THE patience of THE hope
          - Long-suffering, enduring for the expectation of something
          - Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. (Heb 11:1)
    - B. ASSURANCE
      - "Knowing" (v.4)
        - o THE beloved brethren
        - Knowing is the state of mind brought about by finished results
      - THE election of God
        - Chosen by God for God

- The idea of finding favor in the chosen object, a completed act
- o 2 Tim 1:8-9
- The cross, "It is finished"
- "Our gospel"
  - o THE gospel (good news) they brought
  - Not just in word only:
    - With Power, Gr. Dunamis = dynamite
    - With Holy Spirit
    - With Assurance, idea of completely full, full conviction
- 2. EXAMPLE to others (v. 6-10)
  - A. AFFLICTION
    - "Followers"
      - o Became imitators, Gr. Mimeo
      - Not just of Paul, but the Lord too
      - Through much affliction, with joy
      - Joy of the Holy Spirit
    - "Examples" (v.7)
      - Because of the affliction, the joy
      - Example, Gr. Root = to strike, beat out
        - Idea of something molded
        - Evolved into a shape to be a template
  - B. ANNUNCIATION
    - "Sounded out" (v.8)
      - Idea of something proclaimed, sounded abroad
      - The word of the Lord travels beyond the smaller region
      - Their faith in affliction, an example/testimony to others
      - Church speaks for itself
    - "Manner of entry" (v.9)
      - The ACCESS Paul had with them
      - o The AFTERMATH of the effect Paul's teachings had on them
      - o The ACHIEVEMENT (witness) of Paul's impact

- Turned to THE God from THE idols (def art)
  - o Complete replacement or following
  - One false faith to the true faith
  - o Serving God not as a slave, different Gr. Word
  - o Idolatry brings slavery, freedom in Christ
- "To wait" (v.10)
  - Continual process
  - Sense of expectation (theme of this book)
- "Delivered from THE wrath"
  - o Idea of snatching or drawing something out for yourself
  - o Continual process, no set timeline
  - o Wrath = Gr. Orge
    - State of mind, idea of vengeance, long-term anger
    - Compared to Gr. Thumos, Satan's wrath, agitated outburst
    - Rev. 12:12 (orge), 15:1 (thumos)
  - God's thoughts towards us is never wrath but love
  - For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says he LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. (Jer 29:11)
