## 1 Thessalonians Chapter 2

- I. TRANSPARENCY (v. 1-7)
  - 1. EXHORTATION (v. 1-3)
    - "Coming not in vain", not an empty act
    - Paul suffered in Philippi
    - Paul suffered in conflict with them
    - Spoke boldly in "conflict" (v.2)
      - Same word as in Greek games
      - o Struggle, battling for the upper hand, victory
    - "Exhortation" (v.3), 3 comments
      - Not of deceit (error, delusion, false judgement)
      - Not of uncleanness (morally unclean, lewdness)
      - Not of guile (Gr. root = to bait, deceive)
  - 2. EXALTATION (v. 4-7)
    - What is it then? (v. 4), 3 things
      - Approved (tested, allowed)
      - Entrusted (by faith, belief)
      - o Right handling of the gospel (2 Tim 2:15)
    - "Not as pleasing men" (v. 4), idea of softening of the heart
    - Focus should be on God, why?
      - God "tests" our hearts, same word as "entrusted"
      - o Continual action, replenish and refresh
    - Paul did not come under false pretenses (v. 5), 3 points
      - No flattery, "as you know"
      - No "cloak of covetousness"
        - Covet = to have more
        - Cloak = a pretext, outward show
      - No seeking of glory
    - Paul never used his position for authority, Apostle Paul

- Paul never made demands, burden of pressure or weight
- "Gentle among you" (v. 7)
  - As a nurse, caregiver (mother)
  - o Contrary to the 3 points above

## II. TRAINING (v. 8-12)

- 1. Paul's WISH
  - "Affectionately longing
    - o Idea that is ongoing, continuous
    - Paul pours his soul into them
  - "Labor and toil", always occurs together
    - o THE labor, Gr. to beat, force behind the labor
    - o THE toil, Gr. labor, the work done
  - Paul labored night and day (v. 9)
    - o "Laboring", idea of working in a field
    - Manual labor so not to be a burden

## 2. Their WITNESS

- "Witnesses" to their conduct (v. 10), 3 steps in succession
  - Devoutly (right relationship w/God)
  - Justly (deserved righteousness)
  - Blamelessly (no blame)
- Witnessed conduct among the believers as pastor
- "As you know", (v. 11), 3 phases as father
  - Exhorted, Gr. parakaleo = come along side
  - o Comforted, speak kind words
  - Charged, to be a witness (same word)
- V. 12, to have a walk worthy of God, THE called, keeps calling

## III. TESTING (v. 13-16)

1. EXAMINE their actions (v. 13)

- "For this reason"
  - Continual thanks to God, we also
  - o Paul and church happy how they received the word of truth
  - o Inner working, the energy that comes from the Word
- 2. EXAMPLE to others (v. 14-16)
  - "Became imitators of the churches"
    - Same form as above, a noun
    - Suffering the same fate as the other churches
    - Believers all encounter persecution from all sometimes (believers/ nonbelievers)
  - They don't please God (v. 15)
    - o Forbidding the gospel, as Paul was before
    - o Idea in Gr., to cut off, weaken, clipped
    - Kicking against the goads
  - Filling up the measure of their sins
    - Idea of making complete
    - Continually doing what is not right in the eyes of God
    - Wrath comes to completion, the end
- IV. TREASURE (v. 17-20)
  - 1. Paul's EAGERNESS (v. 17–18)
    - "Been taken away"
      - o Paul like a parent, separated from children
      - o Gr. root **apo** = from & **orphanos** = orphans
      - Paul didn't use words to indicate "left behind" or "separate"
      - Personal with Paul, parent imagery
    - A short separation, indeterminate time
      - "Presence" = "Face", same word, eyeball to eyeball
      - o Heart is still very much with them, seat of emotion
    - "More eagerly" (v. 17)
      - o Exceeding measure, overflowing, abundant

- Rom 5:17, "abundance of grace"
- 2 Cor 8:2, "abundance of joy"
- "With great desire"
  - o "desire" Gr. epi = in & thumeeah = the mind
  - Gr. Root thumeeah = thumos, passion / wrath
  - o Tremendous longing, it's all Paul could think about
  - Imagine as parent being separated from kids without control
- (v. 18) Satan "hindered"
  - o Idea of being cut down, not just something in the road
  - o Gal 5:7
- 2. Paul's EXCELLENCE (v. 19–20)
  - "What is our ?"
    - Each word is an assertion of quality (3 elements)
    - o Hope, desire of good w/expection of obtaining it
    - o Joy, enjoyment, gladness, Heb 12:2
    - o Crown, Gr. **stephanos** = crown of victory, wreath
  - "Crown of rejoicing" (v. 19)
    - Paul's boasting of the church
    - Pinnacle of boasting, pride
  - Turned from false gods to the true God
    - The treasure put before the Lord
    - The presence/coming of the Lord
      - Gr. parousia, def art "THE coming"
      - Context determines what coming/presence
      - The rapture
  - (v. 20) "Our glory and joy"
    - o Def art & predicate on both, Paul driving home the point
    - Put forward as specimens, examples to others
    - Paul's crowning achievement
    - Brings him parental joy
