2 Thessalonians Chapter 1

- I. GREETING (v. 1-2)
 - Traditional Pauline greeting
 - Almost word-for-word for 1 Thess
- II. GUIDANCE (v. 3-12)
 - 1. ENDURANCE of their faith (v. 3-4)
 - "Bound", obligated, indebted
 - To give thanks to God always
 - o For the Thessalonians
 - (v. 3) "As it is fitting"
 - o Balances of weight, idea of scales
 - Measuring out 2 comparable things
 - Paul's prayers/thanks are directly proportional to the Thessalonians' actions
 - o Faith grows, Gr. = exceedingly flourished
 - Love abounds, Gr. = to have much
 - (v. 4) Paul is boasting to the churches
 - o Patience & faith, THE Patience
 - o Patience on the Lord leading to the strengthening of faith
 - o Patience accompanies faith hand-in-hand
 - "All persecutions & tribulations"
 - o Persecutions, lit. being followed/pursued by the enemy
 - Tribulations, crushing, squeezing, compressed
 - o "Endure", holding up under the conditions
 - 2. EVIDENCE of God's righteousness (v. 5-10)
 - "Manifest evidence"
 - o Due to patience and faith
 - During trials/tribulations (persecutions)
 - Righteous judgement of God

- Allows trials so we are counted worthy
- The specific purpose is for the kingdom, refining process
- Suffering now and in the future
- Romans 8:18 "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."
- Paul emphasizes the repayment of evil & persecution to the righteous
- (v.6) God dispenses righteous judgement upon those that trouble
 - o Gr. root of tribulation
 - o To press up against someone
 - o Rom 12:17-21, Hot coals on head
 - Proverbs 25:21-22 "If your enemy is hungry, give him bread to eat; if he
 is thirsty, give him water to drink; for so you will heap coals of fire on his
 head, and the Lord will reward you."
- (v.7) Final result is rest from trouble
 - Jesus is "revealed", a grander term
 - o Lit. to remove the veil and expose something hidden
 - o Not just to see a thing, but to <u>understand</u> the thing
- (v. 8) Revealed from heaven with flaming fire, taking vengeance
 - o 2 Peter 3:1-13, Earth reserved for judgment with fire
 - Taking vengeance on the disobedient
- (v.9) "Everlasting destruction"
 - o Separated from his presence
 - Separated from the glory of his power
 - Matt 13:24-30, 36-43, 47-50, Wheat and the tares, (separation and judgement)
- (v.10) Jesus revealed in glory, in that Day
 - o Part of the revealing, glorification process
 - Idea of self-glorification, used only here & v.12
- Glorified in His saints, admired by His saints
- "Admired", Gr. = wondered, worshipped
- 3. ENCOURAGEMENT in distress (v. 11-12)

- Paul & friends always praying for them
 - o Count you worthy of the calling
 - o Fulfill all good pleasure, be filled up
 - o Col 1:9-14, Walking in the strength of God
- Filled with God's goodness, work of faith w/power
- Active power, using God's goodness to a work of faith
- (v.12) Name of the Lord is glorified
 - o His name, reputation, title, character
 - We are glorified in Him, Him in us
- "According to grace", not our work
- Nothing to do with us
- He empowers our faith through grace
- We glorifiy Him through faith, empowers Him to do more in us
